6. Mouth	Upper dental pad slightly forward of lower dental pad		None		Twisted jaw; overshot or undershot jaw	
7. Reproduction	2 firm testicles (buck) or well-formed/balanced udder (doe); 2 teats		Extra or missing teats		Missing testicles; both male and female reproductive parts	
8. Belly Cover	Full coverage with good mohair		Moderate cover; lighter in arm-pits or around udder/testicles		Light coverage or fuzzy non-mohair fleece over belly	
9. Leg Cover	Covered to knee, inside & outside		Light coverage outside of legs; bare inside of front or rear legs (not both)		Mohair does not extend to knees; bare inside both front and rear legs	
10. Topknot	Fully developed mohair topknot		Hairy, kempy or no topknot		None	
11. Chin and Neck Cover	Full chin and neck cover		Covered to jaw but bare jaw-line		Bare jaw-line extending down neck; wattles	
12. Lock Definition	Well-defined locks with good luster		Open fleece with poor lock definition; loose locks; low luster		No lock definition; no luster; double-coated	
13. Uniformity	Fleece uniform in style, character, length, fineness and lock type		Neck 1 grade coarser than main fleece; fleece changes twice; short or coarse britch		Fleece irregular in style, character, length or fineness; more than 2 changes within the fleece	
14. Freedom from Kemp and Medullated Fibers	No visible kemp; minimal medullated fibers <1.5% of the fleece		<1.5% kemp on topline or through britch area; >2% medullated fibers throughout the fleece		Kemp fibers throughout the fleece
